

Raymond G. Jones, Jr., Rear Admiral, USN, is a 1960 graduate of the U.S. Naval Academy. He qualified in submarines in 1962 and his operational experience include: USS GRAYBACK (SSG 574); USS DANIEL WEBSTER (SSBN 626) commissioning crew; USS LAFAYETTE (SSBN 616)(Blue); USS SPADEFISH (SSN 668); USS VON STEUBEN (SSBN 632)(Blue) – XO; USS L. MENDEL RIVERS (SSN 686) – CO; Deputy Commander, Submarine Squadron TEN; Commander, Submarine Squadron SIXTEEN; and Commander, Submarine Group NINE.

Shore tours included: Staff of Commander in Chief, U.S. Atlantic Fleet as Senior Member of the Nuclear Propulsion Examining Board; Deputy Chief of Staff for Logistics and Management (N4), COMSUBLANT; Staff of Director, Division of Naval Reactors; and Deputy Director, General Planning and Programming Division (OP-90B).

In January 1987, he was selected for Flag rank. In August 1987, he reported as Director Total Force Programming/Manpower Division, OP-12, and the following January assumed the added responsibility of Director, Military Personnel Policy Division (OP-13). Rear Admiral Jones served as Commander Submarine Group NINE and Commander, Naval Base, Seattle. He was selected for promotion to Rear Admiral (Upper Half) in October 1989. In October 1990, RADM Jones relieved as Deputy Assistant Chief of Naval Operations for Submarine Warfare (OP-02B). In September 1992 he relieved as Chief of Naval Technical Training. He retired from naval service in July 1994.

Since retirement from the USN he has worked in the Nuclear Power industry as *Senior Manager of Safety Assessment*, Nebraska Public Power District Cooper Nuclear Station, Brownsville, Nebraska (1994-1996) and *President and Chief Operating Officer*, Utilities Service Alliance, Inc., Kansas City, KS. (1996-1999). He then supervised a major DOE project as *Vice President of Fluor Hanford, Inc., Spent Nuclear Fuel Clean Up, Hanford, WA.* (1999-2000). He returned to USN work in 2006 as *Chair Professor of Undersea Warfare, and Director, Undersea Warfare Research Center , Naval Postgraduate School, Monterey, CA* (2006-2009).

Rear Admiral Jones' personal awards include the Distinguish Service medal, Legion of Merit (6 awards), Meritorious Service Medal (2 awards), Navy Commendation Medal (3 awards), and Navy Achievement Medal (2 awards).

Rear Admiral Jones and his wife, the former Sandra Lee Powell, are both natives of St. Petersburg, FL and have two children: daughter Cheryl and son Steve. They reside in Winter Springs, Florida.
